As many of you may know, Casey Irland, was diagnosed with TM in January 2011. TM is a rare neurological disorder that involves inflammation of the spinal cord effecting only 1400 people a year. There is no cure for TM but there are medications that can help with some of the symptoms: muscle weakness, paralysis, uncomfortable nerve sensations, neuropathic pain & fatigue.

“Hope”, “Strength” & “Determination” are the words Casey lives by.
