

Jeff Milano-Johnson Memorial Scholarship

For Section 5 Lacrosse Player

A scholarship fund has been established in the memory of Jeff Milano-Johnson for a high school senior who is a Section V male or female lacrosse player.



Jeff Milano-Johnson died at age 14 on April 11, 2007 of a brain aneurysm. In his memory, a fund has been established in his name.

From this fund we will award one \$500 scholarship to a high school senior who is a Section V male or female lacrosse player AND who has demonstrated his unique combination of characteristics: enthusiasm for life, compassion, perseverance, service to others and creativity (with a touch of goofiness)

Applications and letters of recommendation for the scholarship fund will be accepted up until April 30, 2010.

Jeff Milano-Johnson Memorial Scholarship

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Application Requirements:

Completed applications must be mailed to Jeff Milano-Johnson Memorial Fund c/o M. Milano, 214 Woodland Road, Pittsford, NY 14534 and postmarked by April 30, 2010. **A completed application must include: a statement from the applicant, two letters of references one from a school official (teacher, coach, principal). Letters of reference must come from someone other than a relative or guardian.**

Eligibility:

The application will be open to all Section 5 male or female lacrosse players who are seniors who meet the specified criteria.

Criteria:

The applicant must demonstrate the following criteria: enthusiasm for life, perseverance, compassion, service to others and creativity mixed with a touch of goofiness.

Applicant grade point average must be 2.5 or higher; applicant must have followed all the rules, regulations and procedures of his/her School District.

Applicants must submit a completed application packet which includes:

- the application form with a personal statement
- two references one from a school official (teacher, coach, principal...)

References from a relative or family member are not permissible.

Preference will be given to applicants who have submitted a letter of recommendation from an individual who has been positively affected by the applicant e.g. a community or activity sponsor, employer, minister, teacher, peer or child.

Special consideration will be given to an applicant who demonstrates financial need.

It is not necessary, although it is desired, to award the scholarship each year.

Selection Committee:

The selection committee will be comprised of five individuals chosen by the Jeff Milano-Johnson Fund Administrators.
